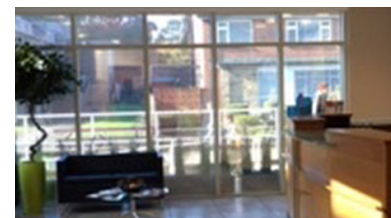
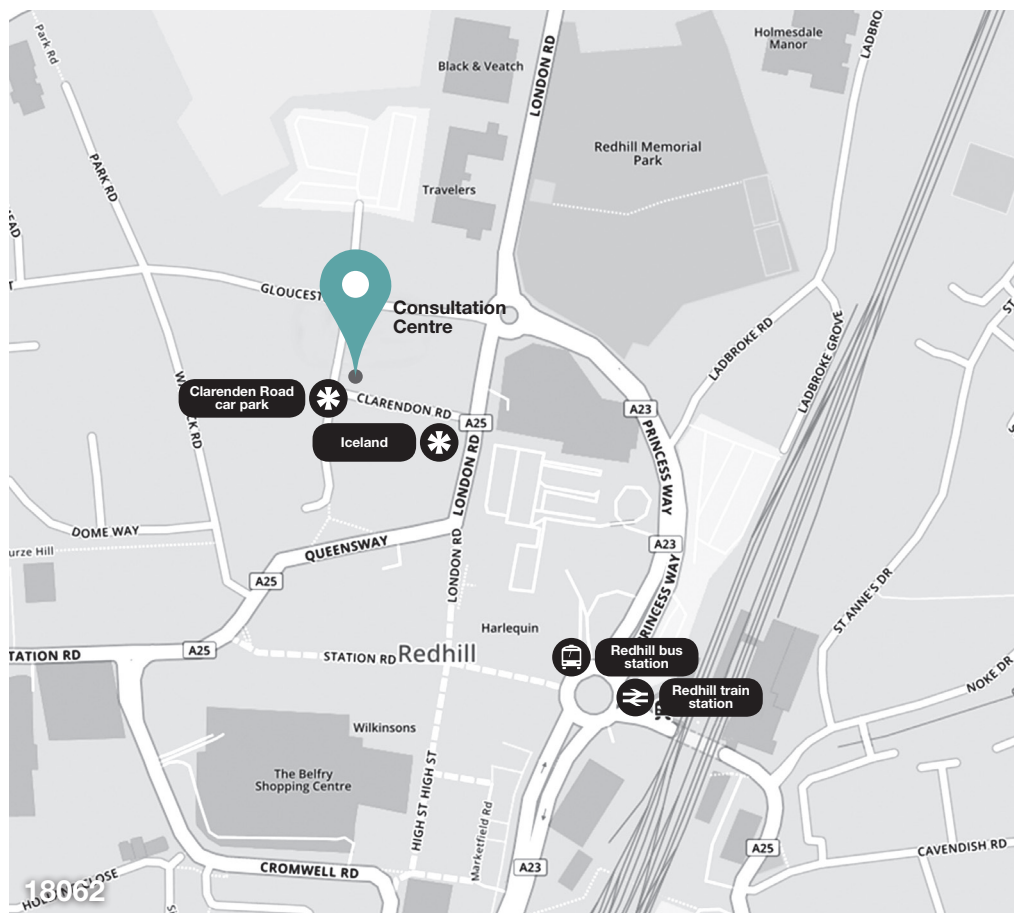


Your PIP consultation is at:

**By car**

We are located just outside the main shopping centre in **Redhill**.

**From Redhill train station**

Exit the roundabout outside the station towards **London/Croydon/A23**. Continue on **Princess Way/A23**, then at the roundabout take the 1st exit onto **London Road**. Take the 1st right onto **Clarendon Road**. The entrance to the multi-storey car park is at the end of the road on the left. The centre is directly opposite.

**By train**

**Redhill station** is approximately **0.3 miles** from the centre.

Exit the station and cross the road with the bus station on your right. Continue

on **Station Road** towards the town centre. Take the 1st right onto **London Road**, continuing beyond the pedestrianised area. Turn left onto **Clarendon Road**. The centre is at the end of the road on the right.

**By bus**

**Redhill bus station** is approximately **0.3 miles** from the centre.

This stop is served by the following bus services:

To get to the centre follow the 'by train' directions above.

**When you arrive**

Remember to bring two forms of ID and your appointment letter with you.

Press the intercom to enter. Please let the receptionist know that you have arrived for your PIP consultation with TICCS. Please note, if your appointment is at 8.00am, there will not be a receptionist on duty, instead a Health Professional will meet you in reception prior to your consultation.

**Other helpful info**

There are four steps leading up to the main entrance. Ramp access is provided to the left of the main door. TICCS is located on the ground floor a short distance from the main entrance. Accessible toilets are available.

**Parking**

Parking is available in **Clarendon Road** multi-storey car park, directly opposite the centre. Disabled parking is available on the ground floor of this car park as well as outside the main entrance of the centre. A drop-off point is located directly outside the centre.
