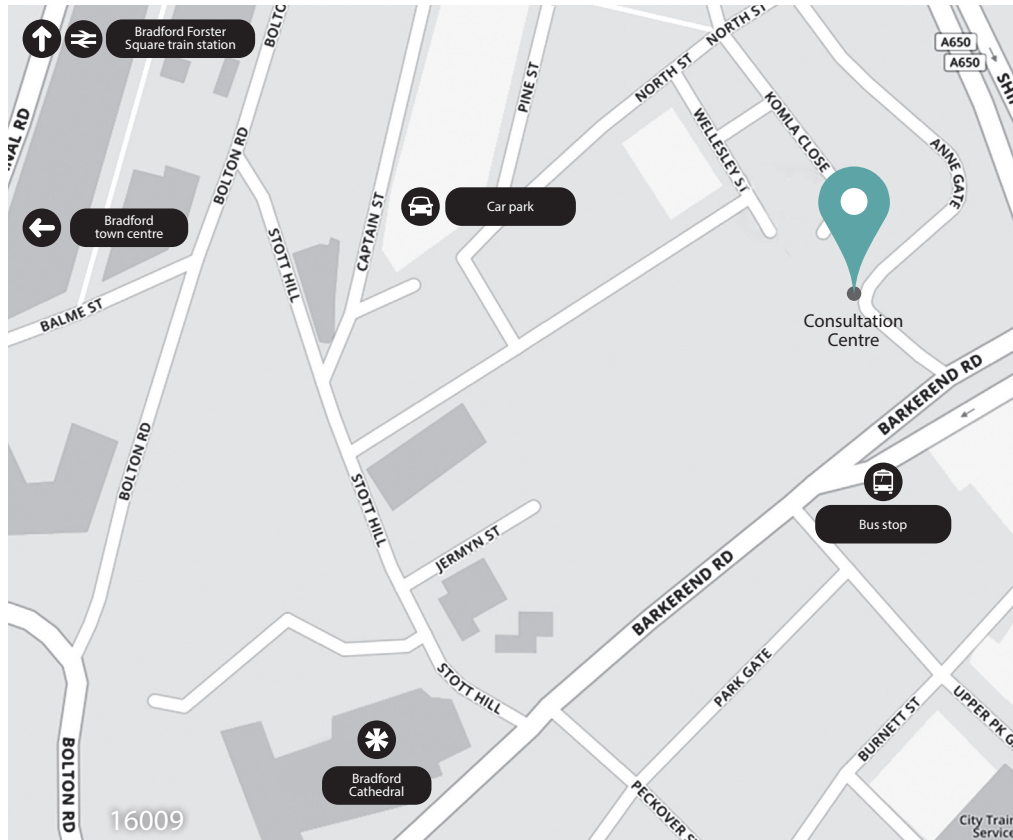

### By car

We are located 0.5 miles from Bradford town centre.

From the Bradford Ring Road/A6177

At the Laisterdyke junction, turn onto Leeds Road/A647 and continue towards the city centre. Continue for one mile then turn right onto Shipley Airedale Road/A650. After 0.3 miles, turn left into North Street. Take the first left onto Anne Gate. The centre is near the end of the road on the right.

For more detailed driving instructions we recommend using an online route planner.

When using SAT NAV, it can bring you behind the building to the Jubilee Centre. The entrance to Anne Gate is by the junction to Shipley/Airedale road. For help in planning your journey door-to-door, go to [www.traveline.info](http://www.traveline.info) or call 0871 200 22 33.

### By train

Forster Square station is approximately 0.4 miles from the centre.

To connect to the centre, exit the station onto Cheapside. Go left towards the

roundabout. At the roundabout take the 2nd exit onto Market Street. Go along Market Street to bus stop M3. Take bus number 611. The closest bus stop to the centre is Church Bank Upper Park Gate on Barkerend Road, a short distance from the centre.

Bradford Interchange station is approximately one mile away from the centre.

To connect to the centre go to Stand Z in the Interchange bus station and take the number 687 bus. The closest bus stop to the centre is Church Bank Upper Park Gate on Barkerend Road, a short distance from the centre.

### By bus

The nearest bus stop is Church Bank Upper Park Gate on Barkerend Road, a short distance from the centre. This stop is served by bus numbers 641, 687, 640, 645, X6, 608 and 72.

### When you arrive

Remember to bring two forms of ID and your appointment letter with you.

To enter, press the intercom buzzer marked 'Consultation' and let the receptionist know that you have arrived for your PIP consultation; they will meet you at the door to allow entry into the building.

Please advise the receptionist if you require the use of the ramp.

### Other helpful info

This centre has step-free access and is located on a cobbled street. It has one ground floor room so please contact the centre if you are unable to use the stairs and we will make arrangements to allow you to attend your appointment.

### Parking

Free parking is available directly outside the centre. Additional pay and display parking is available on Captain Street, 0.2 miles from the centre. Disabled parking and a drop-off point are located outside the main entrance.
